Carolina Cup *April*

The **Carolina Cup race** is a time honored South Carolina tradition that has achieved premier social event status. The annual 'rites of spring' draws over 70,000 fans from throughout the southeast, to enjoy the thrilling sport of steeplechase horse racing amid a flurry of spring fashions and elaborate tailgate parties. From the Corporate Terrace to College Park, old friends meet and new friends are made during the afternoon of seven races.



Colonial Cup *November*

On Saturday, after the week long “**Chase Around the Town**” celebration, thoroughbred horses race along the emerald turf at Historic Springdale Race Course in Camden. The Marion duPont Scott Colonial Cup is the grand finale of the steeplechase circuit - deciding all of the national titles, including Horse of the Year. We are excited to have this years' event combine America's finest steeplechasing with a shopping mecca of boutiques at the Paddock Shops Village, plus infield activities including Jack Russell Terrier Trials, and mule/horse demonstrations. Celebrate Festival *October*
